

## POINTE COMFORT 5 BABY QUILT

Your kit contains:

30 Novelty 5" Squares:  
    12 Bright and 18 Light  
20 Plain Background Squares  
18 Bright Side Setting Triangles  
    4 Bright Corner Triangles  
Backing Fabric

This quilt is assembled "on point". The squares are tipped (see illustration). The easiest way to put the quilt together is to lay out the novelty squares on a design wall, or table. Lay them out with five squares across and six down. The quilt in the illustration has the light novelties around the edges and the bright novelties in the center.



Next, place the 20 background squares between the rows.

The corner setting triangles are placed on top of the novelty squares in the corners. Next, place the larger setting triangles into the notches along all four sides. Your quilt layout should now look like the illustration.

Sew the blocks together into rows. A good system is to begin with the longest row from the top left corner to the bottom right corner. Next, sew the remaining rows, placing them back into your layout as they are finished. [Note: it can be helpful To mark the rows off on your illustration as they are sewn.]

*Optional*  
*2 1/2"*  
*Border* Join the rows. Press your quilt top. Sandwich the top with the batting and backing Fabric. Quilt as desired.
