POINTE COMFORT 6 BABY QUILT

Your kit contains:

- 20 Assorted Novelty 6" Squares
- 12 Background 6" Squares
- 14 Bright Side Setting Triangles
- 4 Bright Corner Triangles Backing Fabric

This quilt is assembled "on point". The squares are tipped as in the illustration. The easiest way to put the quilt together is to lay out the novelty squares on a design wall, floor or table. Lay them out with four squares across and five rows down.



Next, place the 12 background squares between the rows. You may find that the lightest novelties look best around the outside edges and the brighter ones in the center.

The corner setting triangles should be placed on top of the novelty squares in the corners. Next, place the larger side setting triangles into the notches along all four sides. Your quilt should look like the illustration.

Sew the rows together, starting in the upper left corner. Your finished quilt top should measure about 34" \times 40". Sandwich the top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind the quilt and finish by sewing the label on the back.
